Updates

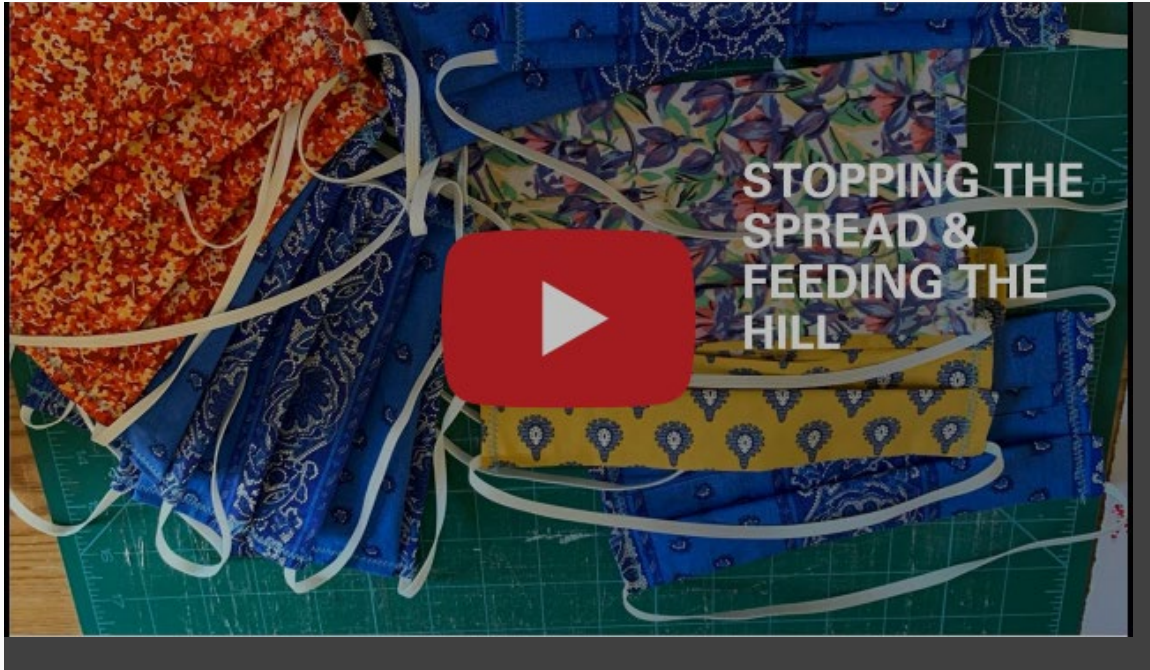
We have now received several more grants, another £10,000 from [London Community Response](#), £5,000 from the [L&Q Placemakers Fund](#) (£5,000 to come); £4,000 from [London Catalyst](#); and £3,900 from the [Charities Aid Foundation](#). Thanks to all for their support of our hard work. We have been promised a total of £32,900.

Thank you to the 403 who have donated through the Just Giving page. The latest figure is £26,961 plus Gift Aid.

Last week, with your help, our volunteers packed and delivered 200 food boxes, to feed over 600 people.

Due to increasing space constraints, we have moved out of the Hill Station to the Craft Room in the Telegraph Hill Centre. Thanks to Jacqui Shimidzu and all the HS team for their support and hello to Zanne Findlay and the Centre team and thanks for their warm welcome.

Our volunteers have also been unstinting in their efforts to raise money. We have taken over £2,500 to the bank this week from mask sales, box sales and other cash receipts. They have also made this rather fetching video....
